Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our discovery topic 'The Potteries', we have booked a trip for all Key Stage classes to Gladstone Pottery Museum. Due to the size of the venue, and the workshops the children will take part in, each class will be visiting the museum on different days.

Tuesday 31st March – Outstanding Owls – Mrs Nevitt

Wednesday 1st April – Fabulous Foxes – Mrs Masterson

Thursday 2nd April – Marevllous Meerkats – Miss Jones

During the visit the children will have the opportunity to explore the museum as part of a guided tour, and take part in a workshop to paint a plate in the style of the artist Clarice Cliff.

The children will leave school by 9:15am and will return by 3.15pm. Your child will require a packed lunch and a drink (disposable/plastic containers only) in a named carrier bag, so that any waste can be easily discarded. If your child has school dinners, we can provide a packed lunch as normal and this can be paid for via Parent Pay. We will otherwise assume that you are providing your child with his/her lunch yourself.

In order to maintain the safety of the children and ensure that they are visible as Oxhey pupils, we do ask that full school uniform is worn on this occasion. We are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£15.00** per child to cover the costs of the three coaches and to pay for the workshop and guided tour (£7.30 per child). Please note that no child will be denied participation on the grounds that a financial contribution has not been made on his or her behalf. However, bearing in mind the cost of the trip, if support from parents is insufficient the trip will be unable to take place.

The trip can be paid for on Parent Pay and this will show your consent for it.
